## SKI TOURING - GRAN PARADISO

**The Gran Paradiso ski touring ascent is rich in contrasts**, set within a magnificent alpine landscape. Starting from Valsavarenche in the Aosta Valley, the larch forests covering the valley's heights gradually give way to vast mineral expanses, followed by glaciers perfectly suited for skiing. The ascent is made on skis up to the foot of the summit, where the final 50 meters, requiring the use of mountaineering equipment, add a captivating technical challenge. At the summit, the silhouette of the Madonna symbolizes the special place Gran Paradiso holds in the hearts of Italians, as the only 4,000-meter peak entirely within Italy. The Victor Emmanuel II refuge, an essential stop, provides the perfect break to pace this ascent. We offer this journey over three days so you can fully enjoy the exceptional beauty of the mountains within Gran Paradiso National Park.

**To discover the mountains of Valle d'Aosta**, we have developed a series of ski tours and trips in the Italian Valley. These adventures allow you to enjoy the exceptional playground of this area while experiencing high-quality accommodations that live up to the region's reputation. Explore also [the Val Magia hut](#), a hidden gem just a few steps from Aosta. Enjoy a gentle introduction to ski touring in the [Val Ferret](#) facing the south side of the Mont Blanc massif. Finally, embark on a [ski tour in Val de Rhêmes](#), which showcases the Italian side of Val d'Isère.

## ITINERARY

### Day 1

Transfer by minibus from Chamonix to Pont (1 960m). We commence our climb to the Victor Emmanuel hut on a steep path through larches. The gradient now eases off and gentle slopes lead to the hut.

*Vertical ascent: 770m*

### Day 2

We climb the Gran Paradiso in a round-trip from the hut. This allows us to take our time and make the most of the atmosphere here. From the hut a climb over an even gradient leads us to the Gran Paradiso glacier (3 200m), then the junction with the Lavaciau glacier (3 600m) and finally the foot of the Gran Paradiso (4 060m). The final 50m require crampons and rope. We are greeted on the summit by a statue of the Madonna and a breath-taking panorama. Superb descent to the Victor Emmanuel hut.

*Vertical ascent: 1350m / Vertical descent: 1350m*

### Day 3

We climb up to the base of the northeast arête of Le Ciarforon (2 935m), from where reach the Grand Etret glacier via a long descending traverse. We put our skins back on to reach the Col du Grand Etret (3 150m) from where we are afforded handsome views of the Southern Alps. We descend the untouched valley of the Grand Etret to rejoin Pont. Transfer to Chamonix, which we reach by mid-afternoon.

*Vertical ascent: 550m / Vertical descent: 1300m*

Group session associates several people who don't know each other. It allows for a planned program to benefit from an attractive price on fixed dates. This formula is ideal for people looking for the friendliness of a group.

## FURTHER INFORMATION

In this section, find all the information about this activity. To prepare your trip effectively, refer to the [guides' tips](#). They share their expertise and recommendations, ensuring you have a great experience.

**Meeting point :** Meet at 08:30 at the Compagnie des Guides office in Chamonix. Transfer by minibus to the departure point. Return to Chamonix by minibus.

**Itinerary :** This is provided as a guideline and may be adjusted according to the group's level and mountain conditions

**Technical Level :** Suitable for skiers skilled in off-piste skiing across various snow conditions and with advanced ski touring experience, including the ability to perform kick turns. The terrain features wide slopes with occasional narrow sections and inclines of up to 35° with sections that may require boot packing with crampons

**Physical Level :** Designed for individuals who regularly engage in physical activity. Expect a positive elevation gain of up to 1,300 meters per day and an effort of 7 to 8 hours each day.

**Guiding policy :** 4 to 5 people maximum per guide. *Registration possible from the age of 18.*

**Accommodation :** During the trip: half-board in huts. Before & after the trip: We have some hotel partners in Chamonix with special prices for our customers.

**Documentation :** Participants must have mountain sports insurance with repatriation cover. We strongly recommend that this also includes cancellation cover. You can take out insurance offering both of these types of cover when you sign up. Participants must also take valid ID with them.

## EQUIPMENT

We recommend you to pay particular attention to the choice of your equipment. It contributes greatly to the success of your stay. Weight is decisive: you always have to evaluate the ratio weight/comfort, to find the best compromise.

### Equipment

- Comfortable frameless rucksack of 35l on which you could fix your skis & ice-axe
- Ski touring skis & shoes, *rentable*
- Adhesive climbing skins & ski knives adapted to your skis, *rentable*
- A pair of poles with large discs, *rentable*
- A pair of light crampons & an ice-axe, *rentable*
- We recommend an helmet for ski touring / mountaineering
- A security pack including harness, DVA, shovel & probe - this pack will be lend by your guide

### Clothing

- Waterproof and windproof, non-insulated parka with hood (Gore-tex or equivalent), *rentable*
- Waterproof and windproof, non-insulated pants, *rentable*
- Thick polar-pile fleece jacket or equivalent
- A light down jacket
- 1 long-sleeve shirt
- Medium weight thermal underwear (top + bottoms, silk or polypro, double as pyjamas)
- Warm ski socks
- Warm ski hat and light sun hat with brim
- Warm ski gloves or mittens
- A pair of thinner/finer gloves (in leather or fleece)
- Neck protection
- Spare thermal underwear (for sleeping and change)

### Accessories

- High-altitude sunglasses (grade 4 is recommended)
- A goggle
- 1.5L water bottle
- An isotherm bottle
- A mini toilet bag including: sun block for face and lips, aspirin, elastoplast, 2nd skin kit, earplug, toilet paper
- A headlamp with spare batteries
- A cotton or silk sleeping sheet: compulsory in every hut. - Hut provide blankets, slippers or clogs
- A plastic bag containing your ID card & Euros for extras
