From the first snowfalls, experience the magic of breathtaking landscapes, serene silence, and pure skiing pleasure. You don't need to be an expert to enjoy ski touring in Chamonix—whatever your level, our local knowledge ensures routes perfectly tailored to your experience and goals.

Exploring the Aiguilles Rouges

The Aiguilles Rouges offer an ideal setting for discovering ski touring. The Lac Blanc area (Col des Dards, Col du Belvédère) is perfect for a first outing in a sunny, panoramic location facing Mont Blanc. The Crochues-Bérard-Le Buet traverse leads to the northern side of the range, through wild and untouched landscapes. On the border between France and Switzerland, the mountains around Lac d'Émosson offer stunning ski touring in remote areas, including Col de la Terrasse, Col de Fenestral, and Bel Oiseau, some of the most renowned routes in the region.

High Mountains and Glaciers

This is Chamonix's true signature: high-mountain ski touring. The Argentière Glacier Basin is a unique location, dominated by majestic north faces. The Passon, Chardonnet, Tour Noir, and Argentière cols are classic routes not to be missed. The Vallée Blanche, between the Combe Maudite and Col d'Entrèves, offers an exceptional glacier skiing experience. Spending a night in a mountain hut—Requin or Cosmiques—allows you to extend the adventure in the heart of the high Alps.

GROUP BOOKING

The group formula associates people who do not necessarily know each other. It is ideal for people looking for group friendliness and attractive prices.

Area of activity

Chamonix Valley

Ability level

To practice ski touring, you need to be comfortable off-piste and in all snow conditions

Formality

Make sure you have valid individual liability insurance for the practice of this activity without any location or altitude restrictions,

including assistance, search and rescue, and repatriation

EQUIPMENT

We recommend that you take special care in choosing your equipment because it contributes greatly to the success of your trip. In general, it is better to stack thin layers rather than having one big garment.

Equipment

- Backpack
- A pair of skis, mounted with ski-touring bindings and Ski Touring Ski Boots
- Touring skins and « ski crampons » specially adapted for your skis
- Ski poles with a large disc at the bottom
- Safety pack: harness and tranceiver

Clothing

- Ski clothes

Accessories

- 1 pair of good quality UV protection sunglasses (level 4) or google
- Water bottle (at least 1 liters)
- Sunscreen protection
- Snacks
