Area of activity:

In Chamonix valley depending on snow conditions

Level:

The snowshoe hike is designed for regular walkers on hilly terrain with a minimum vertical gain of 150m and an effective walking time of around 2 hours.

Formality:

Make sure you have valid individual liability insurance for the practice of this activity without any location or altitude restrictions, including assistance, search and rescue, and repatriation
