Duration: 3 to 4 hours in total (schedules given as an indication), 2h-2h30 hiking Area of activity: In Chamonix valley depending on snow conditions

Level : The snowshoe hike is designed for regular walkers on hilly terrain with a minimum vertical gain of 150m and an effective walking time of around 2 hours.

Formality : Make sure you have valid individual liability insurance for the practice of this activity without any location or altitude restrictions, including assistance, search and rescue, and repatriation
