VALLEE BLANCHE - OVERNIGHT AT THE COSMIQUES HUT

Cosmiques hut - 3 613 m

Located by the Col du Midi and at the foot of Aiguille du Midi, at 3613 meters above sea level, the Cosmiques hut is one of a kind. Second highest mountain hut in France after the refuge du Goûter (3 815m), it once was a laboratory for the study of cosmic rays. The current structure was built in 1991 and is now operated by the Compagnie des Guides de Chamonix. In its basement, the refuge still hosts research activities carried out by the National Centre for Scientific Research. A night at the refuge des Cosmiques guarantees a total immersion in the high mountain world, where the sunrise and sunset are unforgettable.

A legendary run

From the very first step onto the ridge at the Aiguille du Midi, you're immersed in an unforgettable adventure. With the highest peaks of the Alps all around you, the Vallée Blanche offers a 15 km descent and 2,000 vertical meters through the heart of the Mont Blanc glaciers — a legendary off-piste experience that starts with a short ridge walk secured by fixed ropes, and finishes with a return by the Montenvers train or, with exceptional snow, skiing all the way down to Chamonix.

ITINERARY

Day 1

On the way to the Cosmiques Hut

Walk down the Aiguille du Midi ridge, skis on the pack and crampons on your feet. Short ski descent to reach the base of the Cosmiques Hut, then about a 20-minute walk to reach the hut.

Day 2

Vallée Blanche descent

Morning departure, returning to Chamonix by late morning.

A night at high altitude can cause discomfort such as headache, nausea, or insomnia

Duration

From mid-afternoon to late morning the next day

Required level

Normal conditions: ability to ski a steep, mogulled black run in Europe — equivalent to a sustained double black diamond in North America. Not recommended for people with heart conditions

Fresh snow

More technical descent in several dozen centimeters of untracked powder - Class 4/5 level. North American equivalent: Double black diamond + / all-conditions off-piste

△ Suitable skis required

Formality

Participants must have mountain sports insurance with repatriation cover. We strongly recommend that this also includes cancellation cover. You can take out insurance when you sign up

EQUIPMENT

A standard outfit for piste skiing in cold weather is suitable for the Vallée Blanche descent

Equipment

- All-mountain or off-piste skis depending on conditions. Check your bindings before departure.
- One backpack per person to carry skis mandatory
- Crampons adjusted to your ski boots mandatory

Clothing

- Standard ski clothing for cold weather
- Spare clothing at your discretion

Accessories

- Ski helmet
- Sunglasses or ski goggles
- Sunscreen
- Snacks
- Sleeping bag liner
- Pills against headach
- Toilet set (No shower / water at the hut)
