Your children will have the opportunity to learn belaying, knots, and lead climbing, while developing technical skills such as coordination, foot placement, effort management, route reading, and anticipation. This course will also help them strengthen emotional control by overcoming their fears and learning to trust others.

The organization and pedagogy are carefully tailored to each child's level, fostering socialization within the group and team spirit. Sessions held at Gaillands will allow your children to enhance their practical skills in a natural environment. Registration is exclusively open for the four days of the course. - Routes of varying difficulty and profiles: slabs, dihedrals, arêtes, small overhangs
