You will also have to be well balanced to complete this route, which offers dizzying crossings and many unusual passages!

This activity in the Mountain Guides' footstep is accessible from 12 years old and is aimed to people wishing to enjoy an original adventure. At the heart of the winter mountain, it favors a fun and playful approach that makes it accessible to all.

GROUP BOOKING

Ability level : The choice of a suitable destination is essential for you to fully enjoy your trip. This trip is for people who practice regular physical activity. It does not require any previous mountaineering experience.

Formality : Make sure you have valid repatriation insurance for this activity

EQUIPMENT

We recommend that you take special care in choosing your equipment because it contributes greatly to the success of your trip. As alpine conditions can be highly variable with sudden changes, it can get very cold in altitude, it is preferable to have numerous layers rather than one thick piece of clothing.
